Somsara Rielly is a Los Angeles artist, designer & all-around seeker whose given name means "the eternal cycle of birth, suffering, death and rebirth" in Sanskrit. Pulling from personal narrative as well as a lifelong collection of vintage paper and ephemera, her work invites the eye to linger on and re-contextualize the familiar. As seen in the midcentury ideal much of her imagery references, rarely are things as they appear. Her collage and mixed-media work weaves in layers of interpretation, hidden messages, and plays with the seemingly random connections between things. Propelled by a daily meditation practice and keen interest in mysticism, Somsara has a deep desire to find magic in the everyday that surrounds us, while exploring the profound inner world that exists in each of us.
